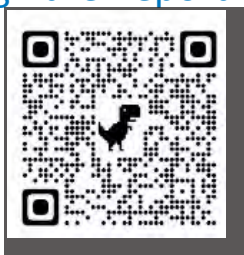

## It is best not to bring the shark on board!



**If the shark is in the sea:** cut the nylon as close to the mouth as possible.



**If the shark is on board:** cut the hook or cut the nylon as close to the eye of the hook as possible. Return the shark to the sea, head first, do not throw it! Hold the shark by the pectoral fin with one hand and the tail with the other hand. Let the shark slide.

**DO NOT** pick up the shark by the tail or the head!

**DO NOT** cut the tissue (or the jaw in a ray) to remove the hook!

**DO NOT** cause additional injury!

**DO NOT** pick up the shark by the gills!

**DO NOT** put your hands in the shark's mouth to remove the hook!

**DO NOT** carry the shark by hooking a ship's hook or something sharp into its body, jaw or gills!

**DO NOT** expose the shark to the sun!
